Confidence in His Words
John 4:46-54

John 20:30-31

³⁰Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

Today's Main Thought: As a follower of Jesus Christ, faith is the essential fuel for daily dependence on His words.

Observations

- Cana of Galilee is the place of the second miracle, vv. 46; 54 (compare John 2:1-11, see the list of the miracles written in the book of John)
- The royal official is in need of Jesus' help, v. 46-47; 49
 - No one is immune to the trouble life will present, Job 5:6-7
 - His desperation motivated him to constantly beg Jesus to come to Capernaum to heal his son
- The royal official took Jesus at His word, v. 50

Confidence Builders in Jesus' Words

- Jesus is more than capable in either joy or pain

- Joy – Wedding Festival, He is the source of joy and happiness, John 2:1-11
- Pain – In sickness and trouble, Jesus' words bring consolation, and comfort, John 4:46-54

- Jesus' words can be trusted
 - He is changeless, Hebrews 13:8
 - He is dependable, Deuteronomy 31:6; 8
- Confidence in His words increases our dependence and influences those around us, vv. 50-53; Psalm 118:6-9

Jesus who are you? The one in whom we can place total confidence.
