John 6:19

Then, when they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and drawing near to the boat; and they were frightened.

Today's Main Thought: Passionate followers of Jesus Christ rowing through life with Him will have peace in the midst of stormy, rough and turbulent times.

Passionate followers of Jesus Christ rowing on their own...

1. Will encounter treacherous waters, vv. 17-18
2. Are in serious trouble and in need of Jesus' help, v. 19; Matthew 14:24
3. Can find it difficult to recognize Him as master over their situation, v. 20; Matthew 14:26; John 10:1-5

Rowing with Jesus

1. **Make sure Jesus is part of the journey**, v. 21; John 15:4-5; Proverbs 14:12.
2. **He knows when our lives are in distress and when we are calling for mayday**, v. 19; Matthew 14:24-25; Mark 6:48.

3. **Don't allow fear, unbelief, embarrassment, or pride keep you from receiving Christ in your boat!**, Matthew 14:26-27; Mark 6:52.
